### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries to be received by the Golf Manager not later than **18 May 2012**
2. Entries limited to 72 competitors of **handicap 12 or less**. In the event of being oversubscribed there will be a ballot by handicap. To compete for the handicap prizes entrants must play off their current handicap on the day of the competition; Maximum 12.
3. The competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, and in conjunction with the local rules of Sundridge Park Golf Club.
4. The McCart Trophy will be won by the player who returns the lowest aggregate scratch score over 36 holes. She will receive a memento and voucher, but the Trophy will be retained by the Club.
5. In the event of a tie for the McCart Trophy, the winner will be decided by a sudden death play-off using the 1<sup>st</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> East; other prizes will be decided by count back. No competitor may receive more than one prize.
6. The right to accept or refuse any entry rests with the Sundridge Park Competition Committee. The Committee will adjudicate upon any matter requiring settlement and its decision will be final.
7. GPS “distance only” measuring devices may be used. Players may not engage the use of a Professional Golfer as a caddy.
